Hazing Prevention Education	Provide evidence-based hazing prevention training including hazing definitions, impacts, and laws  (Address alcohol-and drug-related hazing)	Hazing & Hosting includes state hazing laws and they can add campus policies as a part of course customization
Policy Transparency	Publish hazing policy, reporting procedures, and state laws on institution website  Publish a summary of hazing prevention programming	Embed your campus hazing policy, state laws, and reporting info directly into the course through <b>customizations</b>
Campus Crime & Safety Reporting	Include hazing incidents in Annual Security Report (ASR) under Clery-style format	
Bystander Engagement	Empower students with bystander intervention strategies	<ul> <li>Delivers practical "what to say, what to do" steps</li> <li>Breaks down the Bystander Effect and gives students tools to overcome it</li> <li>Empowers peer intervention with relatable scenarios</li> </ul>
Student Accessibility	Ensure hazing education reaches all student populations (including Greek, athletes, incoming students)	<ul> <li>Easily assign to specific groups and track completion with our SMS</li> <li>Unlimited enrollments make it scalable to reach each student without extra cost</li> <li>Easy sign on for students with campus Single Sign-On</li> </ul>
Campus Hazing Transparency Report (CHTR)	Publish a semiannual public report with hazing violations, organization names, and case details  Include dates: occurrence, investigation start, decision, notification  Keep reports public for 5 years, updated every 6 months	
Institutional Coordination	Train campus security authorities and coordinate hazing reporting across departments (conduct, wellness, safety)	Our <i>Hazing &amp; Hosting Staff</i> course is designed specifically for campus professionals responsible for hazing prevention and compliance. This training supports cross-departmental coordination by equipping conduct officers, wellness staff, Title IX coordinators, and campus police with consistent, actionable guidance.
